Residency in Hematology/Oncology Pharmacy Practice PGY2 July 2012-June 2013

The Advanced Pharmacy Residency in Hematology/Oncology at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center is designed to provide the resident with extensive training in the treatment of cancer, hematological conditions and complications related to chemotherapy.. Comprehensive cancer care is provided via 2 outpatient cancer programs and inpatient adult and pediatric programs. The organization also performs autologous and allogenic bone marrow transplants (BMT). Pharmacists routinely round on the BMT service and provide consultative services to the team. Pharmacists are also actively involved in investigational drug research.

Cedars-Sinai Medical Center is a 960-bed acute, tertiary care teaching hospital located in the heart of Los Angeles, just a block away from Beverly Hills. The Department of Pharmacy Services consists of over 300 staff members and provides decentralized pharmacy services to patients via satellite pharmacies and three outpatient pharmacies in the following subspecialty areas:

The resident will develop a commitment to life-long learning and professional practice through achieving professional competence serving as a member of a multidisciplinary health care team providing direct patient care during clinical rotations in inpatient and outpatient oncology practice. The resident will also develop leadership skills in improving the safety of the medication use system and develop problem-solving skills through participation in departmental and organizational initiatives and provide education and teaching for healthcare team and patients.

Optional: major project throughout the year to be presented at Western States Conference.

Specialized Residency Requirements

- The applicant must be a graduate of an accredited School of Pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy degree and successfully completed (or in process of completing) a PGY1 Pharmacy Practice Residency.
- Candidates must be eligible for licensure in California and resident is expected to be licensed by September of the residency year.
- Staffing requirement 4 days/month

Benefits

Benefits include 26 days of paid time off, 10 of which are used for educational leave, as well as medical and dental insurance.

Application

Motivated individuals with initiative and a commitment to excellence are encouraged to apply. Additionally, successful applicants should possess superior verbal and written communication skills.
