

TRAINING OBJECTIVES MEDICAL STUDENTS

EXPERIENCE SUMMARY

Under the supervision and in close consultation with attending staff, faculty and other expert healthcare staff, the medical student participates in patient care activities to gain insight and exposure to physician practice.

In general, the chain of command for student supervision is from a resident staff, fellow to the attending physician. All students' orders or medical record documentation is to be reviewed and countersigned by the supervising physician.

The specific nature of the experience varies upon the medical specialization through which the medical student is rotating, i.e., Internal Medicine, Pathology, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation (PM&R), Psychiatry, Surgery, Pediatrics, Obstetrics & Gynecology, and Anesthesiology. Programs include a combination of practical and didactic training designed to meet the specific training requirements of each discipline. Generally the programs include seminars/conferences, teaching rounds, clinical and basic science, and research and scholarly activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION

- Current enrollment in a medical school which has an affiliation with Cedars-Sinai Medical Center
